Is a registered participating member of St. Vincent de Paul Parish or can provide a letter of permission from another parish as a registered participating member

Does not outwardly contradict the teaching of the Catholic Church by career, lifestyle, or public statement

Has the capacity to understand that being a Godparent is a lifelong commitment, and fully intends to accept this responsibility

*A member of an Eastern Orthodox community may fill the role as a Godparent in addition to a Catholic Godparent, provided that all other criteria are met. Please indicate if this is the case.

* If letters of recommendation are needed for Godparents, please bring to baptism session or mail to the Rectory Office **two weeks prior to the baptism**. Letters of Recommendation are **NOT** Baptism Certificate of the Godparent.

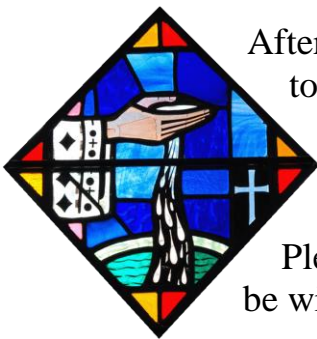
